POSITION DESCRIPTION

The Machinist I is responsible for performing accurate measurements for layout of parts; properly operating lathe, milling machine, and CNC equipment; properly operating fabrication machines (shear, press brake, drills, punches, etc.) for the manufacture of metal parts; reading assembly and detail drawings; and barcode scanning of material and labor to job travelers.

DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES

- Set up and operate lathe, mill, and drill machines.
- Determine sequence of operations by studying blueprints, specifications, and work orders.
- Prepare machines for production by positioning and securing fixtures, stops, guides, and turntables.
- Produce parts by locating and marking reference points on work piece with rule, compass, template, etc. Position or align work piece against stops and guides or with die.
- Regulate machines by setting and adjusting controls.
- Operate equipment, including drilling, reaming, tapping, broaching, grinding, drill sharpening and tool grinding and sharpening.
- Maintain specifications by observing operations, detecting malfunctions, inspecting parts, and adjusting controls.
- Operate miscellaneous hand tools, calipers, gauges, rules, templates, dies, and any other tools required to per the job.
- Other duties as assigned, including special projects.

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND ABILITIES

- Use manufacturing equipment controls and instruments to monitor progress and determine actions.
- Extensive knowledge of manufacturing methods, processes, and procedures.
- Strong working knowledge of quality and inspection requirements, manufacturing processes, and measurement techniques.
- Demonstrated competency with tools required for mechanical inspection (calipers, gauges, etc.).
- Read blueprints and/or drawings
- Follow directions and cooperate, work, and communicate with coworkers, supervisors, subordinates, and/or outside contacts.
